Indspire continues to follow the recommendations of government and health officials in order to help prevent the spread of the virus. Our *Rivers to Success: Mentoring Indigenous Students* (R2S) team continues to work on building content and delivering this program's exclusive blend of mentorship, guidance and cultural resources to First Nations, Inuit, and Métis high school and post-secondary students. Launched on March 3, our online portal already has 2,850 students who have already expressed an interest in joining the program

We were fortunate to host the *Soaring: Indigenous Youth Empowerment Gathering* and to recognize the achievements of 11 outstanding Indigenous leaders from a diverse array of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis communities at the *Indspire Awards* in Ottawa in early March. The 2020 Indspire Awards will be broadcast on Sunday, June 21 at 8 p.m. (8:30 p.m. NT) on CBC, APTN and CBC RadioOne.

We recognize that you are also being impacted by the challenges we're facing today and want you to know how much your contribution means to students across the country and how grateful we are to have your support.
